The Code outlines separate insolvency resolution processes for individuals, companies and partnership firms. The process may be initiated by either the debtor or the creditors. The will promote investments, freeing up banks' resources for other productive uses, boosting credit markets and improving ease of doing business in India. The Code also seeks to balance the interest of all the stakeholders including alteration in the priority of payment of government dues. The Code changes the landscape of resolution and reorganization of companies and introduces a fresh perspective to dealing with distressed companies.

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 is the bankruptcy law of India which seeks to consolidate the existing framework by creating a single law for insolvency and bankruptcy that will provide for resolution of insolvency in a speedier and time-bound manner which would support development of credit markets and encourage entrepreneurship.



The success or failure of the new law will depend on its effective implementation and creating world-class infrastructure for the new institutions created, in particular of the insolvency professionals so that they have the capacity to resolve complex insolvency cases in a timely and efficient manner.
