



Box Cricket RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Tournament format:

- Total 8 teams will be divided into 2 groups A & B. Every team will play a league match against each of the opponents in the respective group. Top 2 teams will qualify for the semi-finals. Topper of each group will play against the team in the second position of the opposite group. Winners of both semi-finals will play the final match for the trophy.
- The maximum squad in each team shall be 8 (the playing squad is 7).
- Each team shall consist of at least 4 players of the age of above 40
- Only the members of KSCAA are allowed to participate.
- 5 overs per innings, 4 bowlers must bowl one over each. 1 bowler can bowl 2 overs.

2. Bowling Rules:

- Stand and Throw (stand at ease Mode) without foot movement is allowed.
- Taking a run up or steps for bowling is not allowed.

3. Wide and No-Ball rules:

- For every wide and a no-ball 1 run shall be awarded to the opponent's team.
- Overstepping the bowling crease, taking steps or run up, Full toss above waist, 3rd bouncer over shoulder height, following 2 warnings are considered as No Ball.
- Free hit is awarded for every no-ball bowled.

4. Boundaries

- If the ball hits the straight wall directly, it shall be considered as 6 runs.
- If the ball hits the straight wall after pitching on the floor or reflected from any other walls (including the roof, right or left walls) it shall be considered as 4 runs.
- 8 runs shall be awarded if the ball directly hits the jackpot board demarcated on the straight walls.

5. Overthrows:

- Batsmen can run on the overthrows. If the overthrow hits the straight wall, It doesn't result in 4's and 6's, but the batsmen can run & score.



6. Fielding Rules:

- No more than 3 fielders in the 2nd half of the ground (Beyond the bowling crease)
- Wicket keeper is mandatorily from the fielding side.
- Catches: Direct catches, no rebounds. For roof rebounds, ball in play but not a catch

7. Others:

- No LBW outs.
- No byes or leg byes are allowed.
- All matches are played in Wilson tennis ball.
- Stumping on no-ball will not be considered as out.
- If the keeper collects the ball before it passes the stumps for the stumping, then stumping will be not valid.
- In case of a tie match, both teams would be provided 1 over (super over) to break the tie. In case of a tie even in super over, each team shall be play one ball each (super ball). Team which scores maximum runs on one ball shall be declared as a winner.
- The batter who has faced one ball in a super ball situation, shall only bat after all the other members of the playing squad has completed their turn.
- A player who has played for a team in any match shall not play for any other team in the tournament.
- No help runners are allowed.
- Substitute players can only field, cannot bowl or bat.
- Last Man batting is not allowed.
- Where no specific rules are mentioned, general cricket rules shall be applied.
- Umpires' decision shall be final. Only captains shall be allowed to speak to umpires in case of any query.
